**RE: 2024 Street Resurfacing Project**

Dear Resident:

As part of our annual Road Program, the Village will be resurfacing streets in your neighborhood starting April 22, 2024. This project will include milling, patching and a fresh asphalt layer that results in a “new” street. Our Village is steadfast in planning and funding a cost-effective Road Program that keeps Burr Ridge “A Very Special Place”.

The Village is resurfacing the following street(s) near your home this year:

**Arrowhead Farm Drive**  
**Chippewa Court**  
**Navajo Court**  
**Omaha Drive**

**Seneca Court**  
**Cambridge Drive**  
**Camelot Drive**  
**Carlisle Court**

**Charleston Drive**  
**Kimberly Court**  
**Forest Edge Drive**  
**Forest Edge Court**

Work will begin mid-April and should be completed by late June. Road construction can be inconvenient, with frequent interruptions from crews and equipment, but the roads will remain open (\*storm sewer work along Charleston Drive and Carlisle Court will have scheduled, daytime-only closures). Please be cautious and drive slowly. Watch for “Fresh Oil” signs that tell you when an oily liquid needed for re-paving has been applied, because the oil can adhere briefly to your tires and track across your driveways.

Your Board of Trustees approved a contract for this work with Schroeder Asphalt Services. Our Community Development Department will be managing this contract to ensure we get the highest quality results. I am the chair for the Street and Pathway Committee, as I have always been for all my terms as your Mayor, because the investment in our roads is important to our Burr Ridge community.
